After serving in the Army during the Korean War, he had a career in life insurance home office management. He retired from First Colony Life in Lynchburg. Jim married Joan Delahunt in 1952 and they had four children, Susan Anderson, Sally Wallace and John Anderson (Ann) all of Charlottesville, Va. and Jeffrey Anderson (Leslie) of Richmond, Va. Joan died in 1986. Jim was active in the Presbyterian Church as an Elder and Sunday school teacher and sang in church choirs for many years.
