He had a strong sense of family and spent many hours gathering information, and writing about his family history. He also enjoyed spending time on Cape Cod during the summers, and loved sailing. In 2002 he moved to Crestwood Manor to help care for Elizabeth who died shortly after moving in. Nelson was also very active in the Crestwood Manor community and had many friends who he enjoyed playing golf, bridge and poker with. He is survived by four grandchildren: Benjamin Clark (Allison), Matthew Clark (Karen), Heather Clark, and Sommer Clark Evert (John), six great grandchildren Nathan, Olivia, Aiyana, Lucy, Cyrus, and Cassidy.
