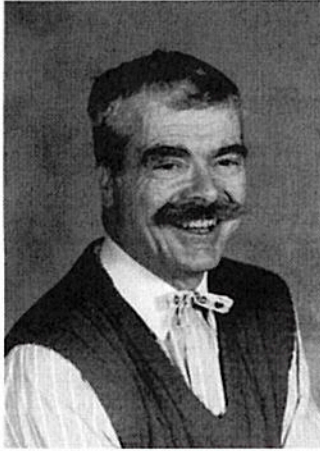

Duncan Denny

NORFOLK - Duncan Denny, passed away at his home on June 19, 2018. He was born June 20, 1927, in New Rochelle, NY, to Dorothy Duncan and Cary Freeman Denny. He is survived by his wife of 63 years, Ayreslea Rowland Denny, children: Bea Tirrell (Charlie), Deirdre Denny, and Rowland Denny (Robin) and grandchildren: Carrere, Andrea, Henry (Robin E.), Amelia, and Reg.

Duncan grew up in Pelham Manor, NY and Norfolk, CT. He graduated from South Kent School in 1945 and served in the Army Air Corps as a radar technician, stationed in the Azores. He is a graduate of Rhodes College, Memphis, TN, and Clark University, Worcester, MA. He coached soccer and taught mathematics at Worcester Academy, St. Andrew's School, Middletown, DE, Sewickley Academy, Sewickley, PA, and Housatonic Valley Regional High School 1969 - 1989.

Duncan was raised to a Master Mason at Western Star Lodge, Norfolk in 1970. He was a District Deputy twice and recipient of the Edward Pierpoint Award. He belonged to Housatonic Lodge, Canaan, and was a current member of St. Andrew's Lodge, Winsted. He was a devoted brother.

He served his community as an assistant scoutmaster, on the board of the Norfolk Historical Society, and participated in the annual Teens Against Polio talent show. He enjoyed performing in musical theater at HVRHS and the Warner Theater.

Duncan sang in his church choirs and also became a licensed lay reader in the Episcopal Church: St. Stephen's, Sewickley, St. James, Winsted, Christ Church, Canaan, Trinity Church, Torrington, and Church of the Transfiguration, Norfolk, where he also served on the Bishop's Committee.
