Dale Davisson Dodd Obituary

Mystic - Dale Davisson Dodd, 90, of StoneRidge, Mystic, formerly of Groton, died Sept. 15, 2017, of congestive heart failure.

Born on Oct. 1, 1926, in Orange, N.J., she was the daughter of the late Alan C. Davisson and Jessie (Tuttle) Davisson of Moultonborough, N.H., formerly of Montclair, N.J. Mrs. Dodd was raised in Montclair, and graduated from Montclair High School and Green Mountain Junior College, Poultney, Vt., Class of 1946.

Mrs. Dodd spent her summers at the "Camp" her grandfather built on Lake Winnepesaukee in Moultonborough.

She lived in Glen Ridge, N.J. for 32 years, where Mrs. Dodd was an active member of the Glen Ridge Congregational Church and also active in Home & School, Boy Scouts, American Field Service, and was chair of Americans Abroad. She worked in the Glen Ridge High School for 10 years before she retired to Groton in 1985.

In Groton, she was active in the Child & Family Agency/Groton Auxillary, serving as a board member for many years, including treasurer and membership chair. She was a volunteer at the Bill Memorial Library in Groton for several years. Mrs. Dodd was an active member of St. Andrew Presbyterian Church in Groton, where one of her interests included playing in the Hand Bell Choir.

She was predeceased by her brother, Alan T. Davisson of Moultonborough, N.H.; and is survived by two sons, Jonathan C. Dodd of Madbury, N.H., and Mark D. Dodd of Chelmsford, Mass.; and a daughter, Lois D. Reuter of Bowie, Md.; five grandchildren and one great-granddaughter.
