Rochester - Kreag Donovan left on his final journey on Sunday, November 19, 2017. He was born on January 1st, 1933. He is survived by his wife, Katherine E. Donovan, daughter Sarah M. (Sheilah James) of Brooklyn, son Peter D., granddaughter Emily L. of Larchmont, and grandson Samuel E. of New York. Also survived by brothers, Dr. Alan B. Donovan (Annie) of Oneonta, and David Donovan (Mary Treiber) of Ketchikan, AK., Anna Ilariucci, Charles' widow, Scituate, MA, and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his parents, Dr. John Arnold and Rosalie Anne (Kreag) Donovan; brother Dr. John A. Donovan, and son Charles E. Donovan.

He graduated from Williams College (A.B., 1954) and Harvard Law School (LL.B, 1957). He was admitted to the Bar in 1957 and became first an Associate and then a Partner at the Harris Beach law firm.

He was elected a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers. He served on a wide variety of Community Boards, including the Board of Directors of Rochester General Hospital; Rochester Health Care Inc.; and White Haven Memorial Park. He was a trustee of the Monroe County Bar Association, a member of Hospital Trustees Association of New York State, and a Fellow at the Rochester Institute of Fellows. His association with The Kent Club allowed him to continue to discuss the finer points of "The Law." He believed strongly that a good education should not be restricted to those who already have much, and became an enthusiastic supporter of University of the Cumberlands, which enrolls students largely from Appalachia.

Kreag was a 50-plus year member of the Country Club of Rochester, where he served on the Board of Stewards, and was currently a member of the Genesee Valley Club.
