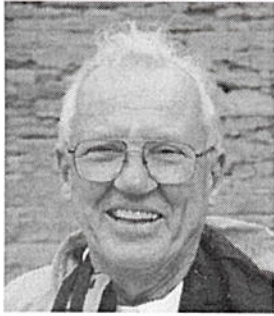

Samuel S. Fuller(1923 - 2016)



Samuel S. Fuller, 93, of Suffield, beloved husband of the late Jane (Purtill) Fuller passed away Wednesday, November 9, 2016 at home surrounded by his loving family. He graduated from Suffield Academy and received his bachelor's degree in business from Williams College, Williamstown, MA. He served with the US Navy during WWII.
