
Earl HENDERSON(1929 - 2019)

On Sunday, January 27, 2019, Earl "Clem" Henderson of Boynton Beach, Florida passed away on the Hospice floor of Bethesda Hospital, having spent his last days in the company of his loving wife Ann and their three sons Tony, Kenneth, and Robert. Born in Hartford, Connecticut in 1929, Clem attended Kingswood School in West Hartford, and graduated from Williams College in 1951. His long and successful career with the Aetna Life Insurance Company spanned 40 years, culminating in his retirement as Manager of Group Sales in 1994. Ann and Clem loved playing golf together for the 63 years of their marriage, and Clem served on the boards of all three clubs where they were members: Brae Burn Golf Club in West Newton, Massachusetts; Brooklawn Country Club in Fairfield, Connecticut; and the Delray Dunes Golf and Country Club in Florida. An aviation aficionado, Clem enjoyed learning about aircraft and the history of flight, and spent many happy hours building and flying his meticulously crafted model planes. An Army veteran who served in the Korean War, Clem was invited to be an Honor Flight participant in May of 2018; he described it as "the experience of a lifetime." In addition to his wife Ann Z. Henderson, Clem is survived by: son Tony Henderson (Carol) of Ithaca, New York; son Kenneth Henderson (Sharon) of Mendon, Massachusetts, with their children Jack and Nicole; and son Robert Henderson of Boynton Beach, Robert's son Michael Flathers (Audrey) as well as their children Michael Jr. and Éowyn. Beloved by his family, and by his many friends and neighbors, Clem will be greatly missed. Services will be private. Clem will be buried in Chicago at Graceland Cemetery.
