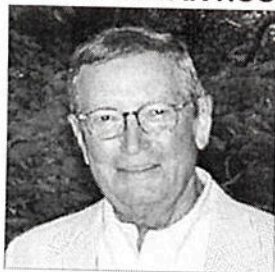

HOUGHTON, Henry Oscar, Jr. Henry Oscar Houghton, Jr., of Concord, MA, died peacefully on November 23, 2017 surrounded by his family. Born in Boston, Harry was raised in Weston, MA. He was a graduate of St. George's School and Williams College, after which he served in the US Army. He was predeceased by his parents Marcia (Clark) and Henry O. Houghton. Harry was the great-grandson of Henry O. Houghton, founder of Houghton Mifflin Company, and the fourth publisher in direct line to proudly bear the same name. Unlike his forebears, Harry spent his professional career at the publishing house Little, Brown and Company, in New York and Boston. He was a volunteer at Emerson Hospital, the American Cancer Society, and the John F. Kennedy Library. He is survived by his wife Jeanette, children Holles (Patrick Swindell) of Brooklyn, NY and Henry, III of Cambridge, MA, his sister, Patricia Dougans of Luray, VA, and his granddaughter Beatrice Swindell.
