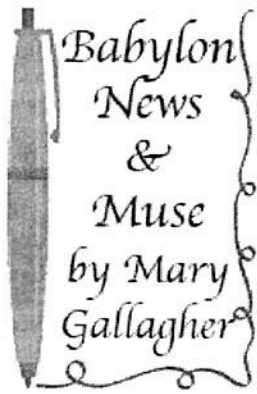






Patrick McGinnis III '57
