**SANDRA PLOUFFE**

PLOUFFE--Sandra Jelin,

deeply loved daughter, mother and wife, and doggedly loyal friend--died on Saturday, February 10, in New York City from glioblastoma multiforme. She was 42. Sandra attended Friends Seminary and Williams College. While working on Capitol Hill in the summer of 1999, a fellow legislative assistant asked her out after a softball game. She married Justin Plouffe four years later. She worked as a health care analyst and ran the outpatient psychiatry clinic at the Children's Hospital in Boston. However, Sandra loved no job more than being a mother to her daughters, Sylvie and Phoebe, and wife to her loving husband Justin. Sandra was a superhuman force who always knew exactly what she wanted--and often what you should want too. She was a founding member of the Williams Women's Golf Team, the Cousins Club, and countless friend groups.
