Comer Plummer Jr.(1929 - 2015)

Comer Plummer Jr. of Wilmette, Illinois, passed on September 12, 2015, at the age of 86. He is survived by his beloved wife of forty-one years, Natalie, his daughter, Dorsey Lachner (Jim); sons, Comer III (Nargis) and John (Kati); and four grandchildren, Lindsey, Katherine, Faris, and John Jr., who were his pride and joy. He was predeceased by his eldest child, Frances Ann, and his cherished sister, Polly. Born in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in 1929 to Comer Plummer Sr. and Pauline (Sewell) Plummer, he was a graduate of Williams College and subsequently served in the U.S. Air Force for two years.
