<p>John Frederick Pohle was born on February 17, 1935 in Fr. Madison, Iowa. He entered into rest on July 27, 2016 in Carlsbad, California. He was an Air Force veteran and served in Vietnam during the Tet offensive. He was a member of the American Legion. John was also a Master Scuba Diver and spent a second career as a research scuba diver along with his wife, Mary. They worked with Dr. Eugenie Clark of the University of Maryland and Mote Marine Laboratory observing and documenting reef fish while on field research expeditions. In 1997 he discovered a new species of deep dwelling sand tile fish in Papua New Guinea which was named in his honor, Hopolatilus Pohle. John was the co-author of numerous research papers regarding various sand dwelling fish. He logged 2290 scuba dives in his life time. His most recent scuba dive, at 80 years old, was down to 140' deep at Matangi Island, Fiji. He was predeceased by his wife Mary Ingles Pohle. He is survived by his only son John B. Pohle and his wife Elizabeth A. Pohle and two grand children, Anna M. Javed and her spouse Omar Javed and Christopher E. Pohle.
