Congreve Hamilton Quinby

Burlington - Congreve H. Quinby, 89, Burlington, VT, died on June 14, 2018 at home.

Born in Rochester, NY to H. Dean Quinby, Jr. and Alice H. Onderdonk on November 28, 1928, he graduated from Phillip's Academy, Williams College, and Seabury-Western Theological Seminary and served as a naval intelligence officer during the Korean War. He married Constance L. Philp in May 1958.

He served churches in So. California and Kansas City, MO, before becoming rector in 1985 of Trinity Church. In retirement, he assisted at parishes in Northern New York as part of the Regional Ministry of St. Lawrence County. In 2002, he and his wife moved to Burlington where he served as supply clergy in parishes throughout Northern New York and Vermont. His concern for the marginalized found new outlets as a volunteer with the Kairos Prison Ministry and co-founder Camp Agape Vermont, a summer camp for children with a parent who is incarcerated. He also volunteered through the Vermont Department of Corrections and Burlington Community Justice Center as a COSA team member helping prisoners reintegrate into the community.

He is survived by his wife; two daughters, Edith L. Quinby (Paul Cochran) and Carol Q. Hunter (Richard); and three grandchildren, Quinby, Laura and Nathan Hunter.

Funeral services will be at 4:00 PM on June 30, 2018 at St. Paul's Episcopal Cathedral, Burlington. There will be no calling hours. Memorials may be given to Camp Agape Vermont, P.O. Box 8283, Essex, VT 05451-8283.
