Frank Dodd Taylor - SAVANNAH - Mr. Taylor was born in 1918 in Pittsfield, Massachusetts. He attended Kent School and graduated from Williams College in 1940. During World War II, he served as a special agent in the Army Counter Intelligence Corps. In December 1942, he married Roberta (Bobbie) Stewart in Trinidad. They were married 73 years. After his military career, he became a Foreign Service Officer in the US Department of State. His assignments included embassies in Paris, London, Berlin and Madrid and later a Senior Foreign Inspector in various parts of the world. After retiring, he and his wife lived in Spain and San Francisco before coming to Savannah in 1987. He was past president of the Savannah Council on World Affairs. He is survived by his wife; a son John S. Taylor of Savannah; a daughter Susan Taylor Wall of Charleston; three grandchildren Spencer S. Wall, Zachary S. Taylor and Elizabeth Wall Murphy and one great grandchild Jameson Taylor Murphy. Funeral services will be announced at a later date.
